

For the Birds

THIS EASY-TO-MAKE SEED WREATH IS SURE TO BE A HIT WITH YOUR FEATHERED FRIENDS



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BIRDSEED WREATH

- ½ cup warm water
- 1 package (¼-ounce) unflavored gelatin
- 3 tablespoons light corn syrup
- ¾ cup flour
- 4 cups birdseed
- Nonstick cooking spray

POUR water into gelatin and stir until dissolved.

WHISK in corn syrup and flour, and stir into a smooth, thick paste.

ADD seeds and stir until they are well-coated to keep the wreath from falling apart (this is the sticky part).

COAT a bundt pan with cooking spray. Using a spatula, press the seed mix into the pan until well-packed and even.

LET sit overnight.

REMOVE from mold by turning upside down on a plate when the wreath is hard and the edible “glue” has turned white.

ADD a ribbon and hang from a tree.

NOTE: This bird treat is best left outside during cooler weather, as warmer temperatures can soften the gelatin, and the wreath may fall apart.
